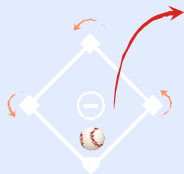



The data submitted on your FAFSA is used to calculate your Expected Family Contribution (EFC), which is 00000. The EFC is not the amount of money that your family must provide. Rather, you should think of the EFC as an index that colleges use to determine how much financial aid you would receive if you were to attend their school. Financial aid may include grants, loans, and/or work-study. This award information will vary from college to college because the cost of attending each is different.
